


The 1,100 acre **Pittstown State Forest** is located on the northern edge of the Rensselaer Plateau north of Grafton Lakes State Park. The forest features several miles of trails maintained for mountain biking and has several excellent views of Capital Region and Adirondacks to the Northwest. Do not park on Shuffle Street until you reach the DEC Parking Area in the forest (end of truck trail). Other access via Keefe Road and State Fire Lane, where camping also available.
