

Debar Pond is a serene glacial lake nestled between Debar and Baldface Mountains, offers invitingly cool waters year-round. Paddlers are drawn to its tranquil surface and the allure of exploring its 86 acres, named after Canadian trapper John Debar who found it in discovered it in 1817.
