

Happy Valley Wildlife Management Area spans nearly 9,000 acres in Oswego County, New York. This diverse landscape features flat terrain, wetlands, and hardwood forests. Managed by the NYSDEC, it offers year-round recreation, including hunting, fishing, hiking, and birdwatching, particularly for Red-shouldered Hawks.
