

**Ohisa State Forest** is a 680-acre New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) property in Herkimer County. This primitive landscape lacks formal trails but offers rugged opportunities for hiking, hunting, trapping, and primitive camping. It is managed for reforestation, timber production, and watershed protection within a serene, unmaintained natural setting.
