

Hartland Swamp Wildlife Management Area (WMA) is a 401-acre protected area in Western New York that primarily consists of shrub swamp, emergent marsh, and open water wetlands. Acquired for the permanent preservation of this diverse natural wetland ecosystem. The area is open to compatible wildlife-dependent recreation, including hunting, trapping, hiking, and wildlife viewing. The site features an observation boardwalk and fishing ponds for visitors to enjoy the natural surroundings.
