



Located in Schuyler Falls, New York, the 1,000-acre **Macomb State Forest** offers a rugged wilderness escape. Once a WWII infantry training ground, it now features five miles of multi-use trails for hiking, biking, and snowmobiling. These lands adjoin the Macomb Reservation State Park and are bordered by Ganienkeh Mohawk Territory to the north.
