

Lake Alice Wildlife Management Area, spanning 1,468 acres in Chazy, Clinton County, was acquired in two stages from the William H. Miner Foundation in 1953 (648 acres) and 1970 (750 acres). Previously used for agriculture, timber, and hydro-electric power generation, it now features accessible foot trails for hiking, skiing, hunting and fishing, allowing visitors and sportmen to enjoy.
