

The **Jockeybush Lake Trail** is a scenic, 2.2-mile round-trip out-and-back hike in the Ferris Lake Wild Forest. It features a gentle 220-foot elevation gain through lush forests, following a stream with small waterfalls. The path leads to a secluded, pristine lake, offering quiet backcountry camping and a tranquil Adirondack escape.
