

Cayuga Shores Wildlife Management Area in Lansing protects 287 acres and over 3,400 feet of pristine, undeveloped shoreline. It features 1.5 miles of trails, seasonal waterfalls, and diverse habitats including hardwood forests and grasslands. Visitors enjoy birdwatching for bald eagles, hunting, fishing, and hiking.
