

Monty's Bay Wildlife Management Area (WMA) is a 318-acre public land in Chazy. Much of the area consists of swamp and wetland habitats, attracting a variety of wildlife. The WMA is open year-round for outdoor recreation, including hunting (deer and waterfowl), fishing, hiking, and trapping (mink and muskrat). It is a significant stop-over point for migrating birds, such as Canada and snow geese in the fall and various puddle ducks in the spring, making it a popular spot for birdwatching.
