

Tivoli Bays WMA located on the Hudson River estuary, is a state-managed area featuring intertidal marsh, tidal swamp, and wooded uplands. It is known for its biodiversity, including rare wetland types, and is designated as a New York Important Bird Area. The area supports diverse wildlife, from migratory waterfowl and eagles to beaver and deer. Visitors can enjoy various activities, including hiking, paddling, fishing, and hunting.
