


Toothaker Creek State Forest spans 709 acres of hilly terrain with rocky ridges and thin soils. The area features a mix of forests, including northern hardwoods, hemlock, and white pine in better sites, and red oak and hickories in poorer ones. Former farm fields now host pine and spruce plantations. Wetter areas support open wetlands, shrub swamps, and swamp hardwoods, creating diverse ecosystems.
