

The Camillus Forest Unique Area is a 350-acre reserve near Syracuse, New York, featuring trails through former farmlands and wooded areas. Visitors can enjoy hiking and birding, traversing easy paths and steeper forest climbs. It offers scenic vistas, including wide-open meadows and distant views. While pets are welcome, they must be leashed. The year-round area is intended for walking only, with some trails potentially muddy.
