

Tibbits State Forest is an 893-acre state forest with hiking, skiing, and horse trails. It features pine, hemlock, and oak groves, and Shingle Hollow Creek, a trout stream. The forest offers hunting and fishing opportunities, and is divided by Route 7 with about four miles of trails.
