

The **Folded Rock Trail** in Battenkill State Forest is a moderate 2.5-mile hike near Salem, New York. Its namesake feature is a dramatic, contorted shale formation created by tectonic pressure. The path climbs steeply through dense hardwood forest, rewarding hikers with a stunning scenic overlook of the Battenkill Valley.
