

Black Creek State Forest in Norway, NY, is a 998-acre public forest in Herkimer County offering a primitive, year-round natural escape. Named for the trout-filled stream running through it, this DEC-managed land features scenic hardwood forests, wetlands, and 1.5 miles of unpaved roads. It is ideal for hiking, hunting, and birdwatching, but lacks designated trails.
