

Tracy Creek State Forest in the Town of Greenwood covers 569 acres of diverse terrain, including open fields and dense woodlands. While it lacks designated hiking trails, explorers can use gated DEC roads and old farm lanes. It is managed for timber, wildlife habitat, and hunting.
