


**Split Rock Wild Forest**, a 3,700-acre preserve in the Adirondack Mountains, features the largest undeveloped Lake Champlain shoreline. Visitors enjoy 11 miles of trails with stunning vistas of Vermont's Green Mountains. This rugged terrain is a vital wildlife corridor, famously home to the rare Timber Rattlesnake and diverse bird species.
