

Located in Steuben County, the 906 acre **Greenwood State Forest** is a primitive destination in New York's Southern Tier. It features limited development, offering a multi-use trail and DEC road for hiking, hunting, and at-large primitive camping. The hilly landscape supports diverse wildlife, including black bears, wild turkeys, and white-tailed deer.
