

Nine Corner Lake is a pristine, deep-water destination in Ferris Lake Wild Forest. The easy, 1-mile trail follows red markers and a scenic stream with waterfalls, gaining about 300 feet. You'll find several primitive, roadside-style campsites along the shoreline. It's a popular spot for swimming, paddling, and exploring the Adirondacks' premier bouldering fields nearby.
