

Bear Swamp State Forest is a 3,539-acres in southeastern Cayuga County. It offers over 14 miles of multi-use trails for hiking, mountain biking, cross-country skiing, and snowmobiling, with primitive camping allowed. The forest contains the high point in Cayuga County and protects Bear Swamp Creek, a vital, unfiltered tributary to Skaneateles Lake.
