

Madawaska Flow is a 228-acre boreal waterway in New York's Adirondacks, prized for canoeing and rare birdwatching. Access is via a 6-mile dirt road off NY-458; however, this route occasionally faces seasonal closures or restrictions due to its logging within the Santa Clara Conservation Easement.
