

Located in Titusville Mountain State Forest near Malone, NY, the **Elephant's Head Trail** is an easy-to-moderate 0.8-mile hike (one-way). It features a 320-foot elevation gain and a summit staircase. The peak offers panoramic views of Lake Titus and the northern Adirondack region. When the seasonal access road (Elephant Head Road) is closed, you must park at the gate near State Route 30 and walk the unpaved road to the trailhead. Additional Road Walk: 1.5 miles each way. Total Round-Trip Distance: Approximately 4.2 to 4.6 miles.
