

Clark Hill State Forest spans 2,819 acres, purchased between 1933-1950. Formerly pasture and cropland, it features hilly, rocky terrain, streams, and scenic views. Includes tranquil woodlands and gorges. Only Buck Hill Road is fully plowed in winter. Latteiman and Boody Hill Roads are partially plowed.
