

Big Alderbed. 2½ mile trail back to a scenic lake held back by an old dam. The trail is generally fairly easy to follow to where it crosses the East Canada Creek a half mile before the Big Alderbed though some of the markers are hard to find. Beyond the low-water creek crossing, the trail is overgrown and harder to follow, some follow Proposed Boyer Lake Herd Path (unmaintained) to the south side of lake during high water conditions, however there is no maintained campsite on that side of lake.
