

Bullhead Pond is off Chain Lake Road before the gate and dam on Adirondack Lake. It is an easy, short 1.2-mile round-trip hike. The path follows an old wood road that is mostly wide, flat, and well-maintained. The final 100 feet features a steep descent straight down to the shoreline, which can be slick during wet weather or winter conditions. The pond is surrounded by a dense forest of tamaracks, which turn a vibrant, spectacular gold late every autumn.
