

Valcour Island a 968-acre jewel in Lake Champlain and part of the Adirondack Park, is accessible exclusively by boat from access points like the nearby Peru Dock . It features approximately 29 primitive, first-come, first-served campsites with basic amenities like fire rings and pit privies. Visitors can enjoy hiking the seven miles of trails, fishing, and exploring historical sites like the 1874 Bluff Point Lighthouse . The protected bays offer excellent anchorage for both motorboats and sailboats.
