


Wurstboro Ridge State Forest, near the famous hair-pin curve on old NY 17 was once mined for lead. In more recent years, it was proposed to be a housing development. To protect the Basha Kill and the scenic valley below, 1,100 acres were added to the state forest system, providing hikers with views of Basha Kill Valley below.
