


Skinner Hill State Forest spans 1,666 acres across Sherburne, Columbus, and New Berlin. The land was once farmed by the Skinner family. Today, it's a mix of Spruce and Pine plantations, natural Hardwoods, open fields, and wetlands, offering diverse landscapes. The forest's unique shape and varied ecosystems make it an interesting area to explore.
