

Grape Hollow State Forest is a newly protected 505-acre natural preservation area located in eastern Dutchess County. Established in 2024, the forest spans across the towns of Beekman and Pawling. It acts as a critical wildlife corridor and a permanent scenic buffer for hikers along the iconic Appalachian Trail.
