


Rogers Island WMA is a 281-acre Hudson River island managed for wildlife habitat and recreation, including hunting, fishing, and birding. Accessible only by boat, it features forested uplands, tidal marshes, and mudflats. It is also historically significant as a major British military complex during the French and Indian War and the "spiritual home" of the U.S. Army Rangers.
