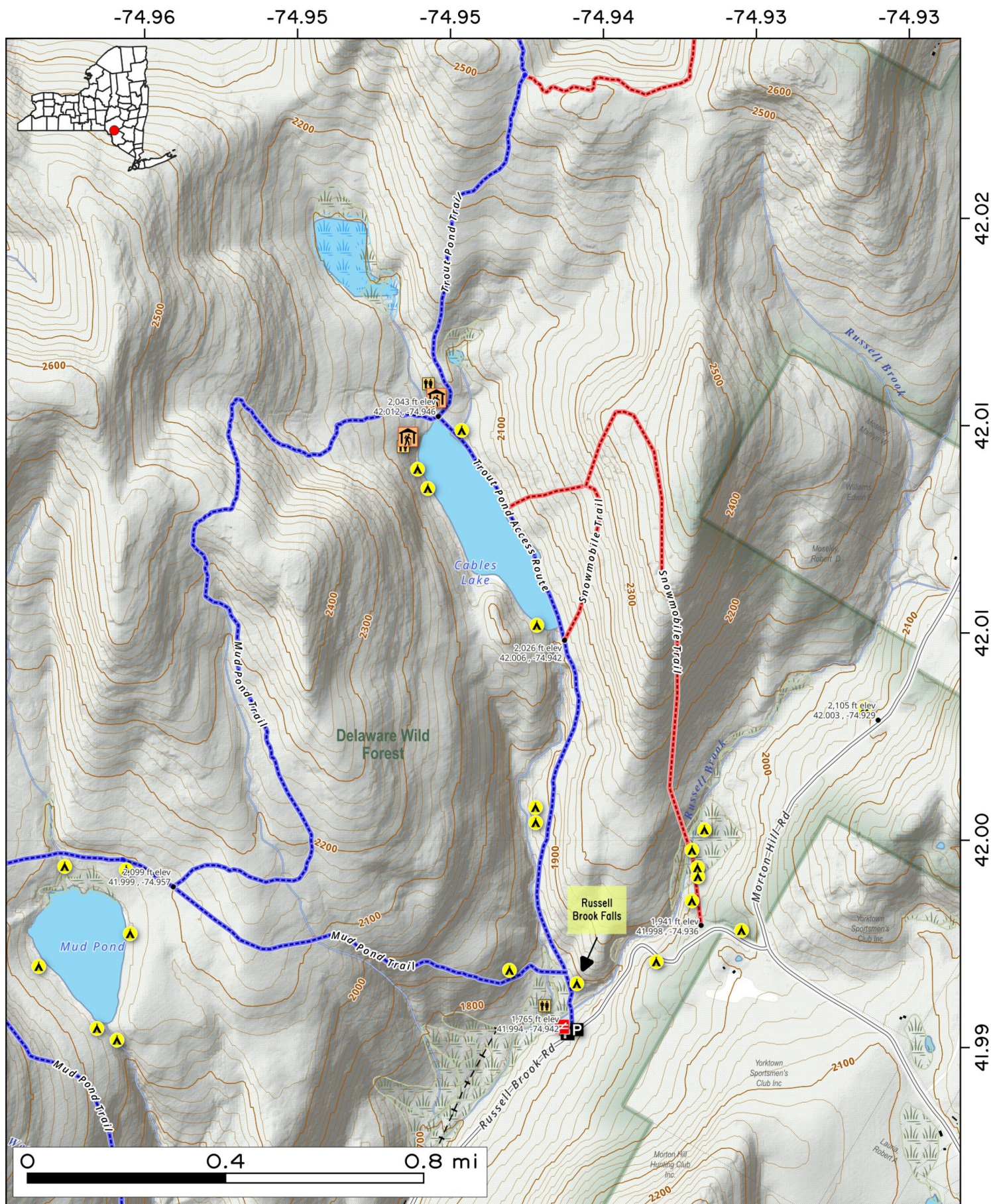


The Cables Lake Trail (or Trout Pond Trail) is a scenic, 1.8-mile gated old woods road in the Delaware Wild Forest. It winds gently uphill of Cables Lake. The trail starts near to Russell Brook Falls, a stunning 50-foot double-tiered cascade located just yards from the trailhead.

The **Mud Pond and Cables Lake (Trout Pond) Loop** via Russell Brook Road is a follows old roads in the Delaware Wild Forest near Roscoe. Depending on your route, approximate 4.4 to 7.6-mile loop that showcases pristine mountain waters, dense Catskill forests, and a stunning hidden waterfall.
