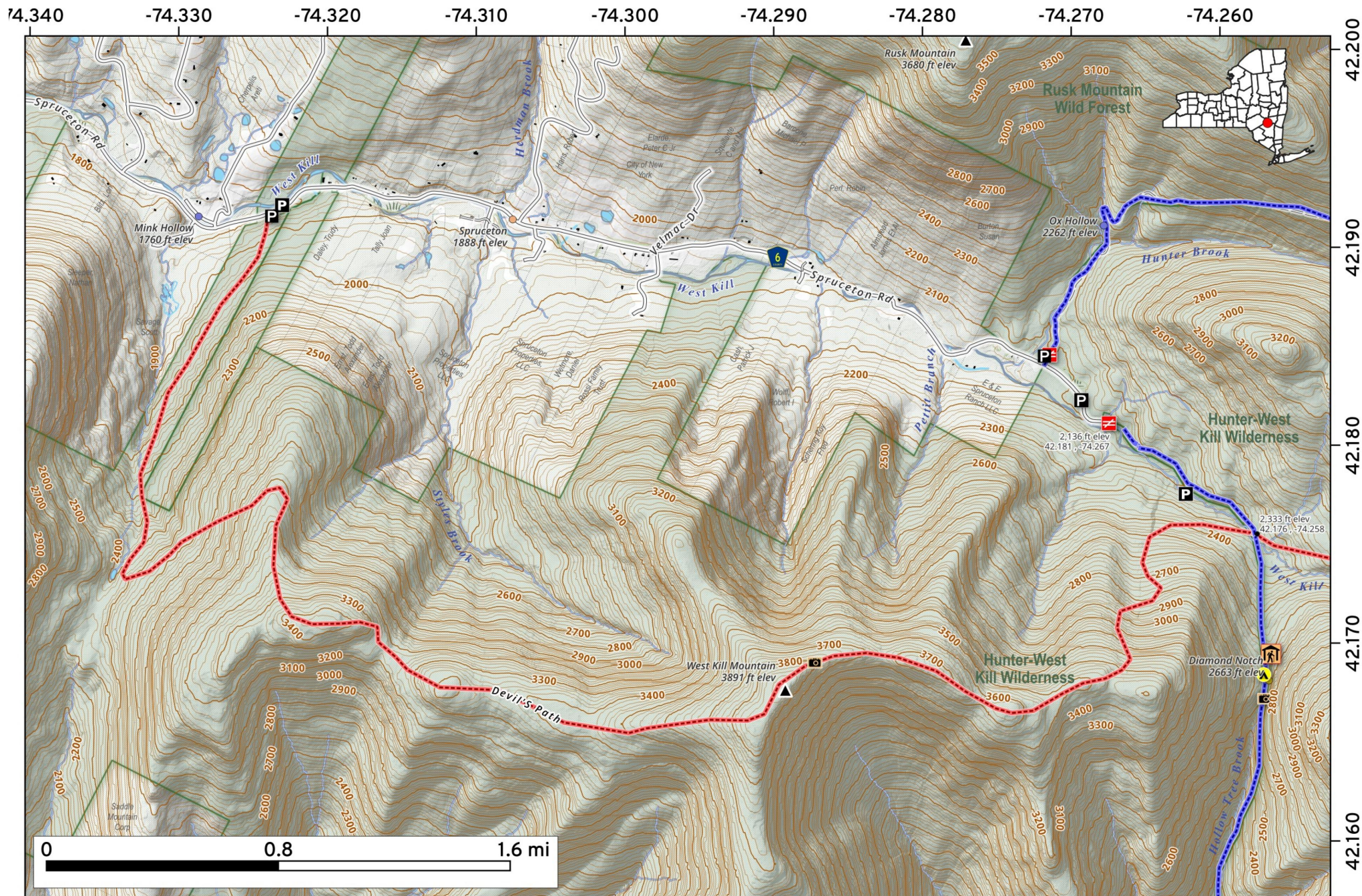


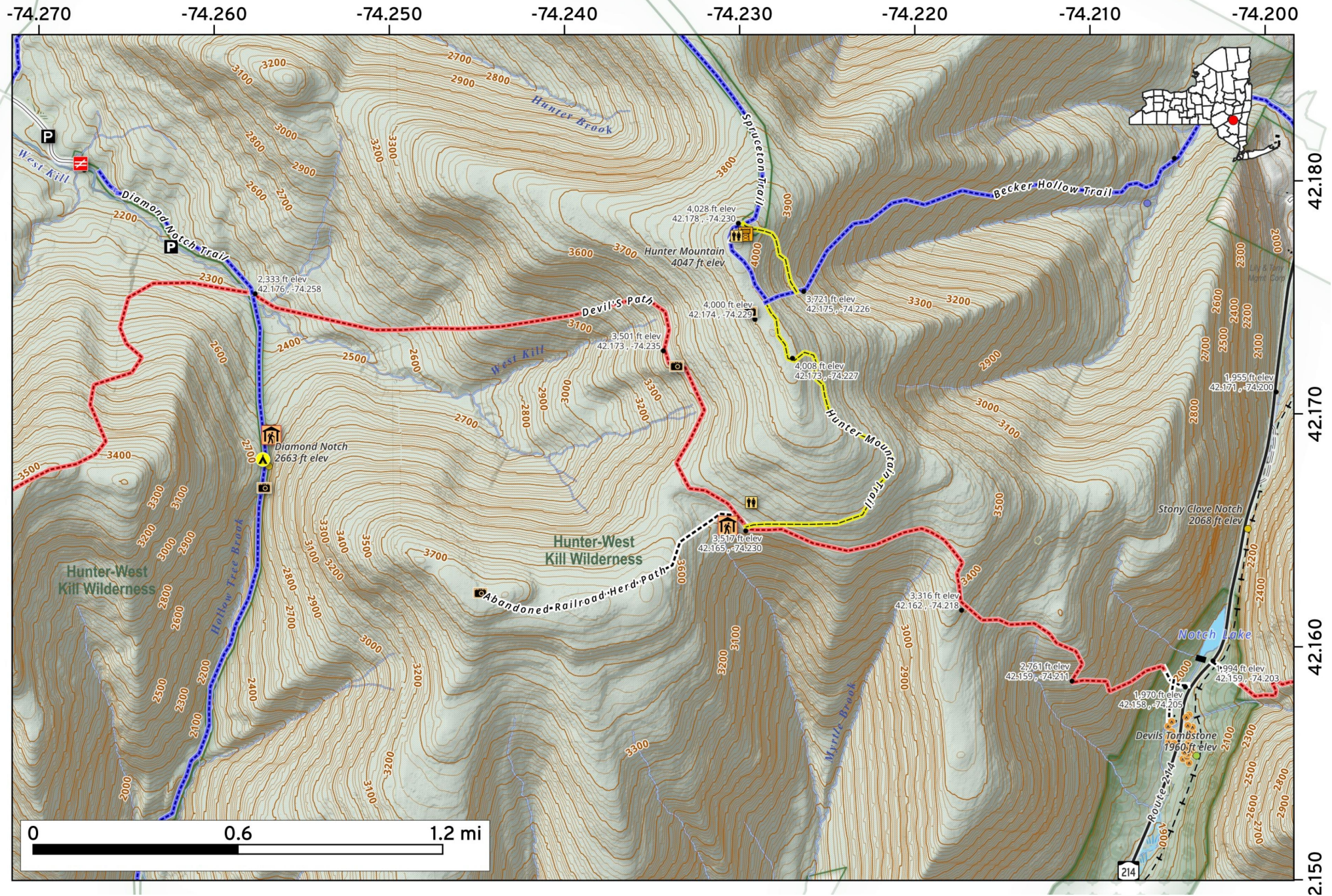
Devils Path - Map 1 West Kill Mountain. Section from Spruceton Road West Kill Lot to Spruceton Road - Diamond Notch Trail.

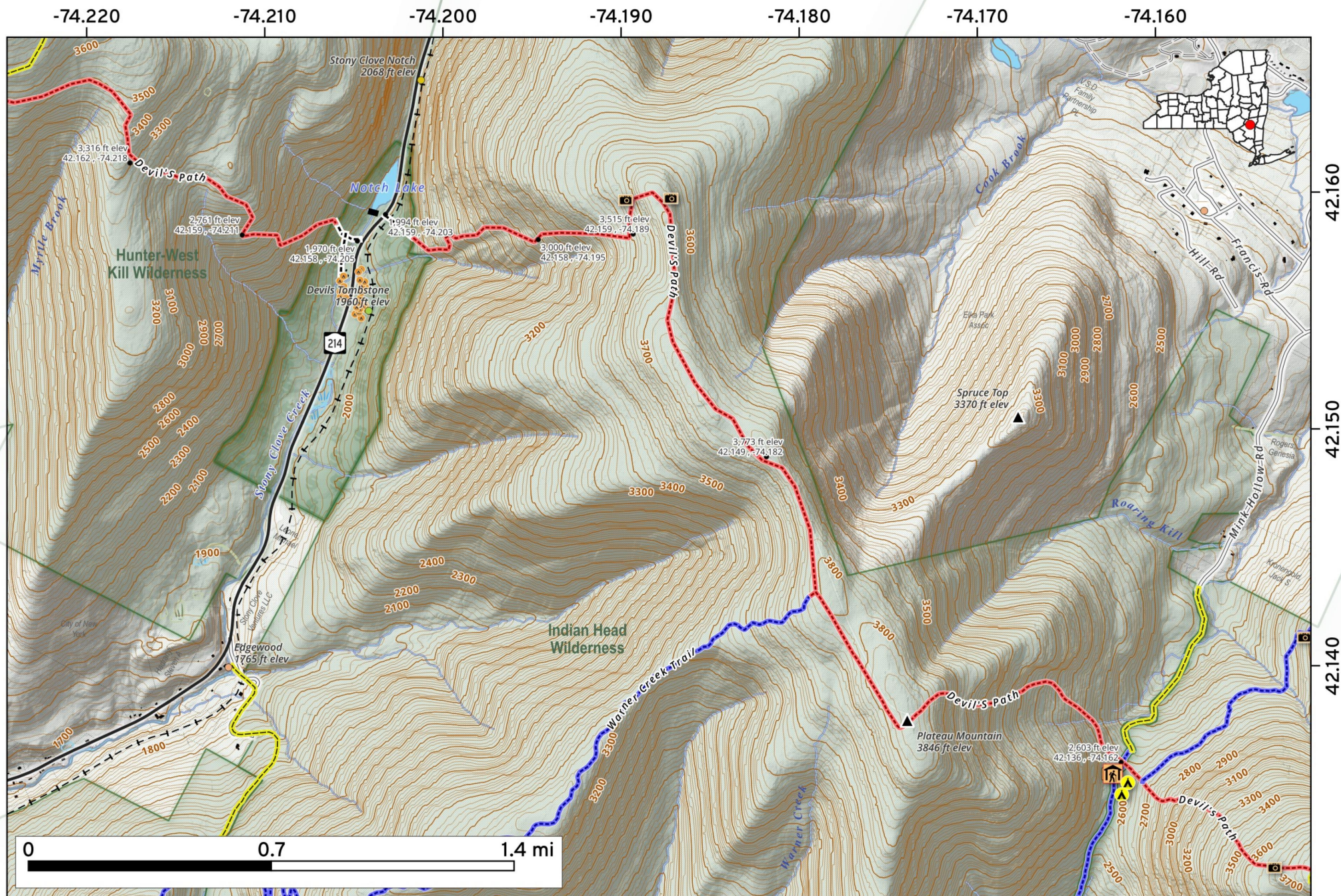

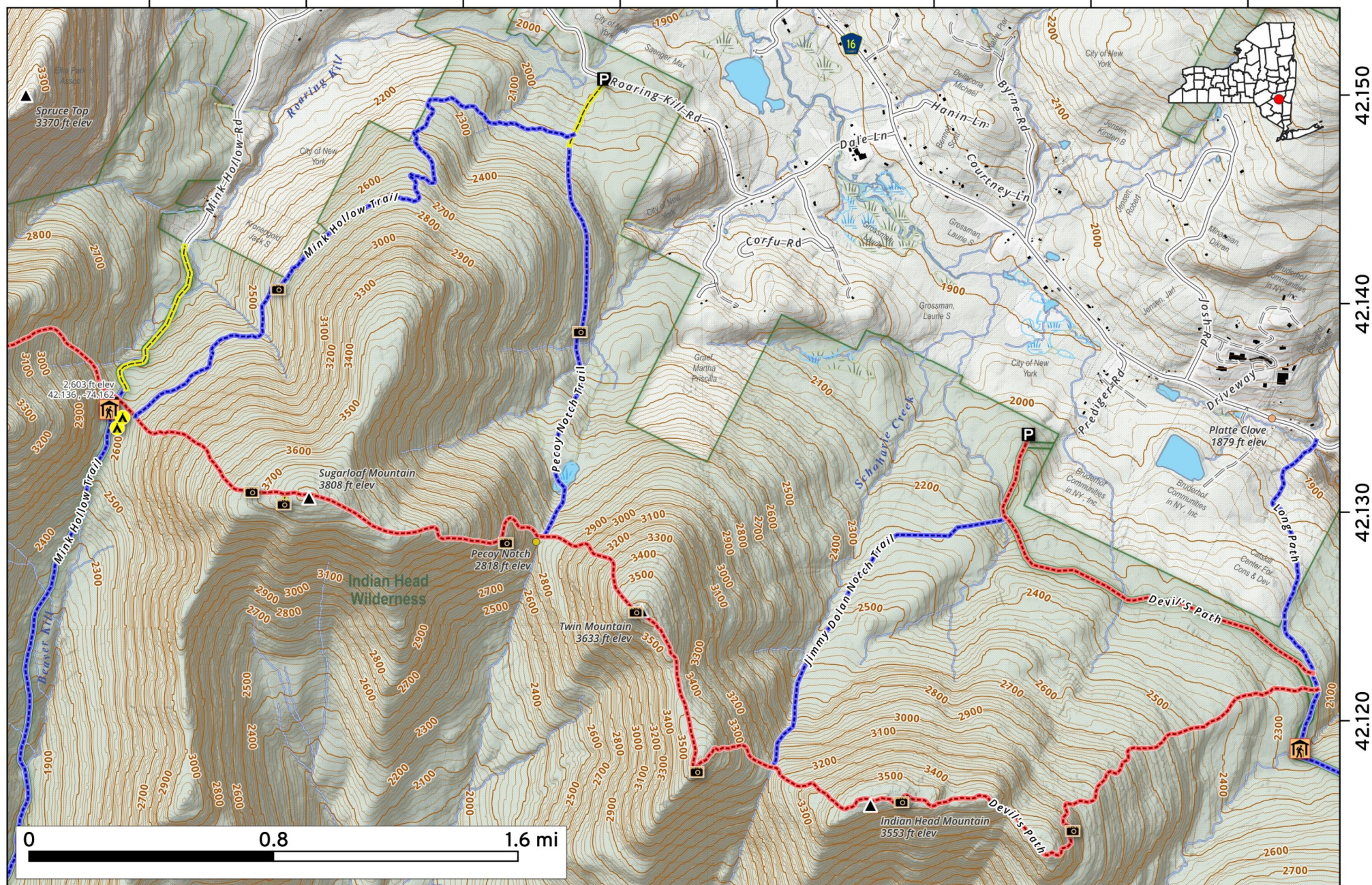


Devils Path - Map 3 Plateau Mountain. Section from Devils Tombstone - Notch Lake and NY 214 to Mink Hollow.
