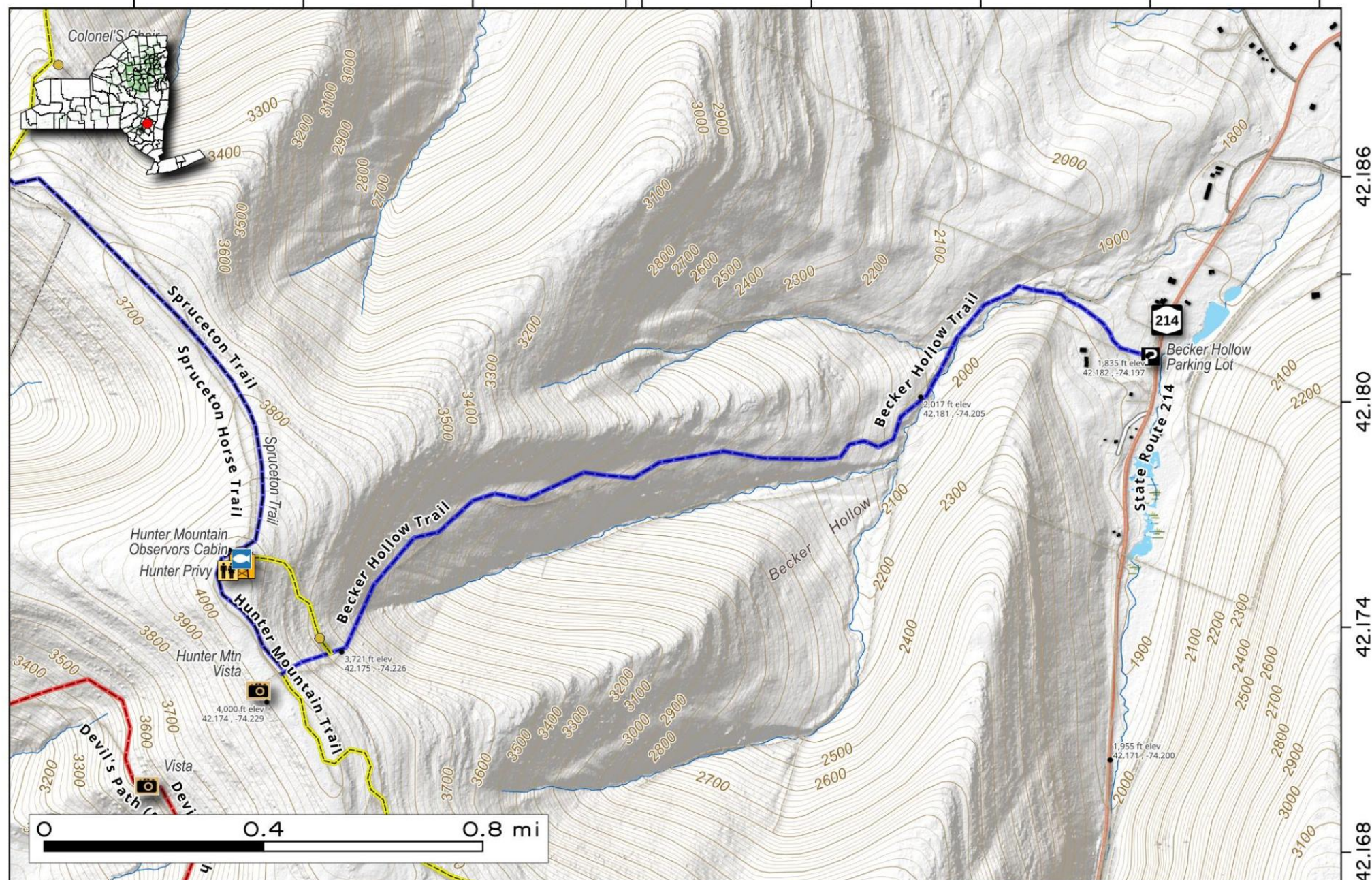
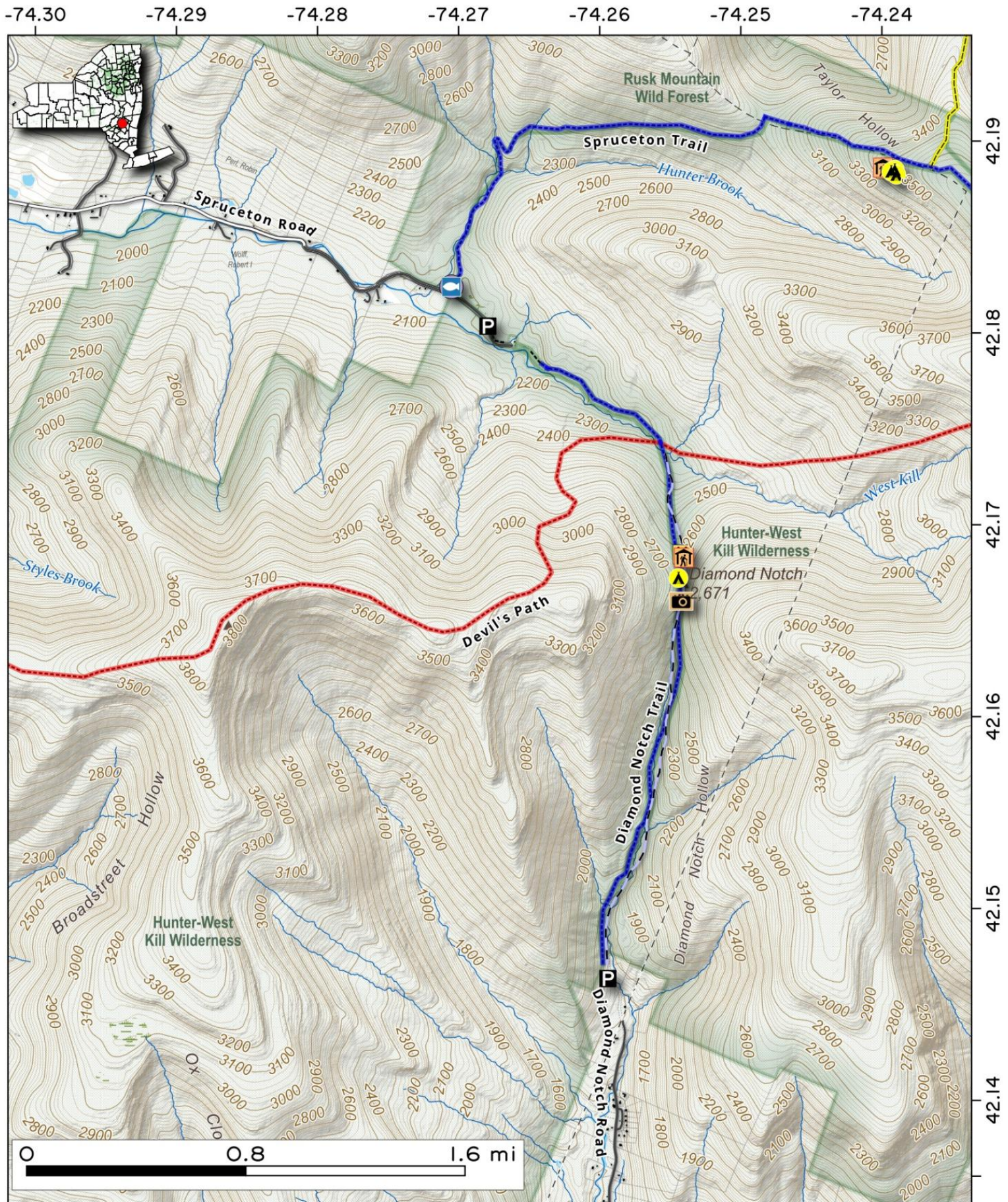

The Diamond Notch Trail in the Catskills spans 2.2 miles, offering a moderate hike with diverse terrain. Hikers pass through lush forests, cross streams, and ascend rocky paths. Notable spots include the scenic Diamond Notch Falls and the junction with the Catskill Escarpment Trail, providing stunning vistas.
