

Italy Hill State Forest, in New York's Finger Lakes region, is an 1,899-acre forest offering rustic recreation and diverse wildlife habitats. Managed for timber, wildlife, and water quality, it provides opportunities for hiking, hunting, snowmobiling, and nature watching. It crossed by the Bristol Hills Trail.
